Species able to be commercially fished

While there appear to be a large number of species permitted to be taken for commercial sale, those underlined in bold are the main commercially caught species inside the lakes and Coorong. Many of the other fish species are found in the marine zone and all fishers are entitled to fish out to the 3 mile limit. Some species are also able to be harvested for bait purposes.

The variety of species allowed to be caught reflects and maintains the multi species, rotational harvest strategy that has helped the fishery remain sustainable over the past 160 years.
